Already supported Projects by the Office of International Cooperation

Fight against acute bacterial meningitis in Niger

For a better understanding of space-time dynamic of meningitis epidemics in Niger and the factors responsible for their emergence and spreading in order to support control and prevention strategies.



Fight against antibiotics resistance in children (Cambodia, Madagascar, Senegal)

First program studying a large pediatric international cohort in low-income countries with the aim of optimizing the diagnostic and treatment of bacterial infections, and to control the emergence of new resistance mechanisms and to limit spreading of resistant bacteria.



Funding of students from « Global South » in Public Health to attend the Pasteur-CNAM Advanced Master's degree courses.
